

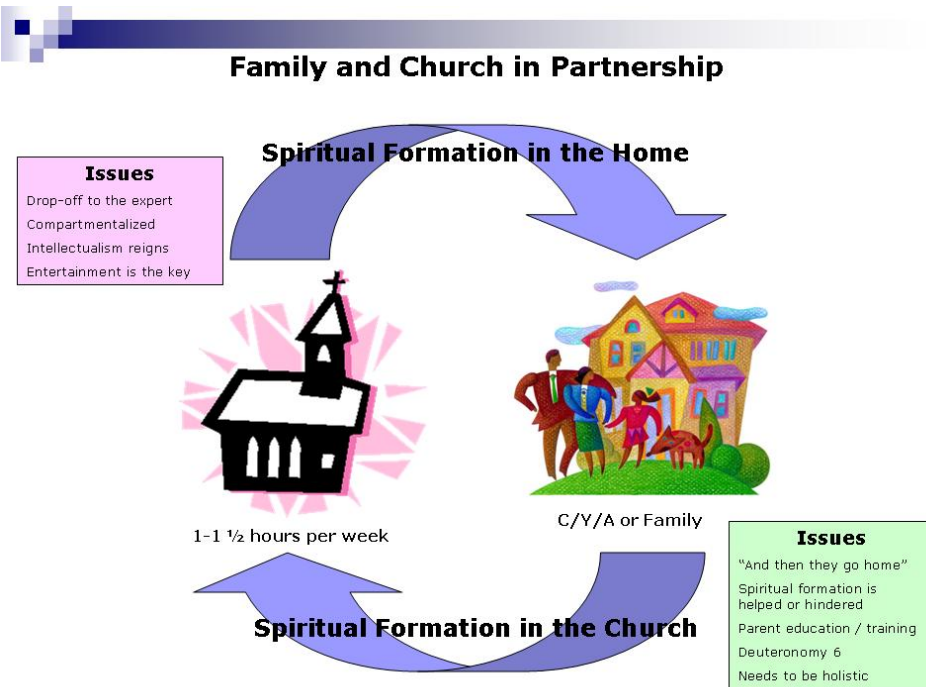

How Do Churches and Families Connect in Partnership?
